

## SUMMARY SHEET

P.1 Born in Wales 1912, one of four brothers.  
Educated in Wales and Kent (Chatham House School, Ramsgate).  
Went to Oxford to study chemistry.

P.2 Came to Grammar School, Kendal in 1935 to teach maths and physics.  
Living in at the school. Still boys boarding. Played rugby.

P.3 Only five boys boarding. Stark accommodation.  
Classes of between 25-30 pupils. Alan Thompson, Geoffrey Webb, Percy Duff, Sanderson Temple in same form

P.4 Roe Thompson, headmaster.  
Took over the making up of rugby teams for the school. No games master.  
Lessons on Saturday mornings 9 a.m. - 12.00.

P.5 Jones, teacher at the school, keen climber.  
Taking boys to Wasdale Head and Langdale.  
McClellan taught English. Webster, art master.

P.6 Webster, portrait painter, died young.  
Playing dame in school panto.

P.7 Discipline.  
Some boys left early because of family circumstances.  
Universities and examinations.

P.8 Fee paying pupils.  
School Certificate examination and Higher School Certificate exam.  
Joined army in 1940. Married to local girl.

P.9 School caps worn.  
No connection with High School.  
Shared premises with girls' school during the war. Some classes held at Zion Church.  
Only about 150 pupils at Grammar School.  
Became headmaster at Rivington & Blackwell School, Lancs.

P.10 Played rugby at Mintsfeet, but changed at baths in Allhallows; no clubhouse. Travelled to Manchester and Yorkshire area to play rugby.  
Travelled to Lansdowne Road in Dublin to play rugby. Sammy Martindale.

P.11 Alec Johnson, captain of rugby team; compensated if injured whilst playing.  
Boarded with three colleagues with Mrs Beer at Aynam Lodge.

P.12 Joined Literary & Debating Society and Dramatic Society.  
Rehearsals at restaurant in Stricklandgate, and on Highfield.

P.13 Dramatic Society put on two productions a year.  
Joined Operatic Society: Merrie England Belle of New York.  
1937 rehearsed for Miss Hook of Holland but war intervened.

P.14 Operatic Society rehearsed in Spiritualist Hall, Waterside.  
Productions held at St. George's.

P.15 Costumes hired, and scenery. Professional orchestra.
