- P.1 Born at Tebay, 1918. Left Tebay School at 14.
Joined railways, aged 20 (LMS).
- P.2 Porter at Cark-in-Cartmel. Worked at Oxenholme station for £2 per week, late 1930s.
During '39/45 war worked at Camforth, Cark and Kirkby Lonsdale as porter/signalman.
- P.3 Returned to Kendal station after the war. Became signalman. About 20 staff employed clerks and van deliverymen.
- P.4 Staff at Cark and Kirkby Lonsdale.
Shoes and snuff went by passenger train from Kendal station.
- P.5 Excursion trains. Clubman's train went from Windermere to Manchester.
- P.6 Became crossings man at Bumeside.
- P.7 Wide loads going through Bumeside station.
- P.8 Bank engines at Oxenholme helping trains up Grayrigg and Shap summits.
- P.9 Shifts .worked at Camforth, Kirkby Lonsdale and Kendal.
The 'Whip'.
- P.10 Crossing duties at Bumeside.
Quiet station at Kirkby Lonsdale.
- P.11 Lighting on railways during '39/45 war.
