Home on Castle Crescent. Evacuated daughter to parents
Noise of River so loud she had to shout for her neighbour to hear her
Left house and to get to car - water was three feet deep.
Parked car on Thorny Hills

Track Two, pp.1-3

Daughter's father wanted to go back to house, tried to stop him Lifeboat on Sedbergh Road

He got as far as the junction between Castle Street, Castle Grove & Sedbergh Road Stayed overnight with parents

Her street was being shown on TV News

Went back the following morning – the area in front of the house was like a lake Water had got to a foot high in house

Track Three, pp. 3-4

Searched round Estate Agents for accommodation, could not believe she was going to be out of her house for six months.

Rang Estate Agent re flats in K Village, already taken.

Lady had given backward on a flat in the same complex.

She took it just as the woman came back having changed her mind

Got keys for flat the following Saturday

At the time of the interview work had not started on repairing the house
