Managed to get home on Kendal Parks in his 4-wheel drive car.

His colleague unable to get home. Stayed at Castle Green Hotel.

Houses on Hallgarth were flooded due to drainage problems.

There had been five feet of water in the Furmanite workshops at the height of the flood.

Returned to work on the Monday after the flood.

Had to move equipment into various storage facilities to have it cleaned and sterilised.
